



This season, both of our leagues - GGSA and CFL - have successfully transitioned back to in-person tournaments. During the years of online competition, student participation in league tournaments has declined somewhat, but we are now making progress in reversing that trend. Novices are wearing oversized suits, an HI kid is telling jokes to a wall, parent volunteers are serving Chinese food, everyone in tab is listening to Gay Brasher's stories and hanging on every word. We're back, baby.

I am also proud of my colleagues for all the time they spent thinking about setting up tournament logistics in a way that would protect public health. I've attended coaches' meetings at both leagues, and was impressed with how much thought league members put into the details of their safety protocols.

Let me also use this opportunity to plug the new GGSA website at ggsa.org

There, folks can find detailed judging instructions for each event, student resources, league updates, and more. The new and streamlined membership registration page provides instructions on how to join CHSSA in addition to the local league.

In CFL, we've piloted a new registration system that allows schools to cover the fees for joining both CFL and CHSSA in one payment. Along with CHSSA streamlining the registration process on its end, this helped ensure that by the time State Quals came around, all the CFL member schools were also CHSSA schools in good standing. I hope we can build on this success in future years to keep the registration process as intuitive and painless as possible. Let's have coaches spend less time with paperwork and more time with students!

This past fall, CHSSA welcomed two new at-large representatives from our area - Lexy Green and Julie Herman. Both are legendary coaches, and both have been instrumental in running the local league tournaments in our area (but only one of them beat me out for a Copeland speaker award when she was in college). CHSSA is very lucky to have them on its Board this year. I hear they've been killing it in the debate committee!

With all the work that's been going into rebuilding and expanding this year, I can confidently say - the state of Area 1 is strong.

CHSSA Hall of Fame Inductee:

Terry Abad

Lowell High School

Since 2006 the Lowell High School speech and debate program has been a bedrock of success, pportunity, and excellence in the speech and debate community, thanks to the hard work of head coach, and most importantly, Lowell alumni:

Terence "Terry" Abad. Terry's sixteen years of commitment to speech and debate have been filled with competitive success, leadership roles, and friendships that e

xtend beyond forensics. This year, the California High School Speech Association is proud to

welcome Terry Abad as the 2023 CHSSA Hall of Fame inductee.

When talking about Terry one common thread pops up among everyone who knows him: Terry is always willing to step up when he is needed. This has lead to Terry serving as the Golden Gate Speech Association league president (2008 - 2016), District Chair for the NSDA San Francisco Bay District, the head of the judge room at the James Logan Invitational

tournament for many years, and as state tournament host in 2012 when Terry hosted at

Lowell High School. In that time Terry has always worked hard to innovate, including being the first state tournament host to bring in food trucks for attendees, a practice that is now copied year after year! Indeed, this leadership role comes naturally to Terry.

In fact, when the California High School Speech Association needs someone to lead a vote process, it is Terry who gets the call because everyone knows he is reliable, and has the relationship with his fellow coaches to get the job finished. It is no surprise that in 2019 he was awarded the Donovan Cummings Service-Above-Self Award for his many years of stepping up when needed. As fellow coach Michele Lamons explains, "I have watched Terry Abad facilitate tournaments at all levels for nearly twenty years. Terry has worked these events from the ground up: hosting, running TAB, and as a judge liaison. He has held multiple officer positions in the GGSA, and as one who knows the rules,

regulations and ins-and-outs of both Speech and Debate. His dedication to Forensics is unparalleled."

While serving in these many leadership roles, Terry still makes the time to lead his Lowell students to success. As GGSA President David Matley explains, "Despite a complete lack of experience as a forensics competitor or coach, Terry helped rebuild the Lowell program in

terms of both participation and competitive success while remaining true to legendary Lowell coach George Lorbeer's mantra: "The only losers are those who do not participate." More than 60 Lowel I students have competed at the state tournament during his tenure, including the 2016 Parliamentary Debate champions and the 2017 runners-up."

Within the coaching community Terry has left an impact as someone who is always ready to provide a dose of integrity, positivity and joy into everyone's day. Hall of Fame coach Mikendra McCoy explains that "Terry remembers names and faces, he always engages with questions about your person, then your



team ... he makes you feel like you matter in a world that usually only lets you matter if yo'rue able to gain the titles."

And of course, any write up about Terry would be remiss if it didn't mention that no coach can rival the style, fashion, and je ne sais quoi that only Terry can bring to a long day in tabroom. Perhaps tournament director and Vice President of Activities Angelique Ronald sums it up best, "Terry's legacy is unmatched. Whether running his own successful team,

helping GGSA thrive behind the scenes, or always stepping up to volunteer his time at State, Terry is always reliable and quietly exceptional. Plus, his style is just unmatched."

In case you did not know, Area 2 is the largest of the four areas, as it covers the most distance in the state; while others have the population, we have the land. And what beautiful land it is! The Central Valley, also known as the "Great Valley of California," spans from below Bakersfield to above Sacramento. While the distance is extensive, traveling is worth it, as the sites are truly something to behold! Seeing the Cascade Mountain Range to the north, the Sierra Nevada to the east, the Tehachapi Mountains to the south, and the Coast Ranges and San Francisco Bay to the west, the Valley sits in the central location with access to everything.

Perhaps the Valley's most notable quality is its agriculture; more than 250 different crops are grown here; predominantly grains, vegetables, citrus, tree fruits, nuts, table grapes, and wine grapes; making it responsible for 40% of the nations food, all while being the least hydrated, as 20% of the Nation's groundwater demand is supplied from pumping Central Valley aquifers.

The aforementioned is more than just a bold flex or an information overload; it exposes the reality of the region: Area two is rich with possibility, and yet, the resources here are simply stretched too thin. The similarities to the world of speech and debate are uncanny; with such diverse populations, amazing cultures, and high schools filled with students seeking the opportunity of speech; we are unfortunately seeing a ton of turnover. As we know, to everything there is a season and a time to every purpose; here in the Central Valley, it is a season of change.

On that note, we pause to honor several notable coaches who are stepping away from the activity, as life is taking them in another direction: YFL: Michelle Van nieuwenhuyzen (Turlock HS), Zack Kopeki (Enochs HS) and Kris Freitas and Alyssa Conroy (Buhach Colony HS) and from SVFL: Milla Smith (Bullard HS). Thank you for all that you have given to Speech and Debate. You certainly have contributed to the growth of students, yielding incredible intellectual crops and making a difference in the world as they were mentored and trained, for years, in the art of communication and life. We thank them for their dedication and commitment to the activity, invite them to any tournament to judge when they need a "forensics fix," and wish them well-earned rest and anticipate the adventures that this next phase will bring.

However, that means that the many vibrant communities of Central Valley are looking to replenish their resources; seeking graduates who wish to return to the valley to make a difference, calling on educators to step into the activity, and inviting anyone to come to the Central Valley! We welcome all!

Whether it is helping with the state tournament, making the lives of coaches easier by training and advocating for them, or planning creative ways to get the community together for even non-competitive experiences, his career is filled with respect for the work.

Ashley Novak, SCDL President, and longtime colleague of Derek explains, "I've been working with Derek since 2000 and he spends countless hours thinking about how we can consistently do better. The most recent example of this was during the depths of the pandemic. Tabroom was just terrible. Just about every single improvement--and there were



hundreds of them-- was made because of those countless hours he spent on the phone with the NSDA just trying to make it simpler for all of us. If you notice that it is better, it's because of Derek. He never has any ulterior motives other than making competition fair and equitable for all kids. Even though his kids regularly are very successful, he's very aware of the need for other schools to be noticed and creates so many opportunities for them to grow and thrive." Former Vice President of Activities Nermin Fraser agrees, "Derek really is the embodiment of Service Above Self - I have counted him as a friend, colleague and mentor for 20+ years and in that time he has never made a decision that wasn't 100% laser focused on making things better for the kids."

Indeed in every conversation you have about Derek the common thread is that he is someone who steps up, and makes things happen. Jessica Wilkerson from San Gabriel High School says "Derek believes in the Speech and Debate program and makes it his job to ensure that all students have the opportunity to participate. He's ALWAYS willing to help if it means that students are in the program, participating, and having fun with it." And Area 3 Chair Leilani Mchugh shares, "As we've returned to in-person tournaments, he is the first to step-up as a hosting school and in celebration of this return and of high school Speech & Debate, he has organized Speech & Debate Day at Knotts Berry Farm in May, an opportunity for our students to come together outside of competition. We hope to see other teams in California come and enjoy the 2nd such Speech & Debate Day that Derek has planned. This year scheduled for May 16th, 2023."

Angelique Ronald, current tournament director and Vice President of Activities is always welcoming of the support Derek provides. "I (very selfishly) appreciate that Derek is always available to talk through issues and brainstorm solutions, always just a phone call away, even at absurd hours of the night. It's something that I have always been so thankful for— and so have the last four State Tournament Directors, since we've all done the same. He would absolutely hate me saying so, but Derek is an integral part of the annual success of our State Tournament."

Despite his aversion to the spotlight, Derek has been bringing positive attention and growth to our activity as a coach for many years, and his hard work and dedication are something we all can aspire to as we continue to build out the important activity of

Forensics in the state of California. It is a great honor for the California High School Speech Association to award the Donovan Cummings' Service Above Self Award to such a deserving coach and colleague.



WHAT DOES SPEECH AND DEBATE MEAN TO YOU?



WHAT DOES SPEECH AND DEBATE MEAN TO YOU?





WHAT CAN WE DO TO INCREASE ACCESSIBILITY OPPORTUNITIES FOR SPEECH AND DEBATE STUDENTS FROM DIVERSE OR MARGINALIZED BACKGROUNDS?

Since I work on the debate side of things, I think it's important to form resolutions that leave no room to question people's right to exist. We should limit the room for people to make racist, homophobic, etc. arguments and make sure to correct them when they do. Until prejudiced argumenting is no longer used, debate is not a real safe space. In addition, I think we should be less strict about dress codes, which are often unconscious expressions of sexism, racism, and classism.

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT FOR SPEECH AND DEBATE STUDENTS TO BE ADVOCATES?

Students in Speech and Debate are some of the few young people who have already gained the skills required to be an advocate. We understand the importance of communication, in both listening and speaking. We are well-versed in policy and the real impacts it has. As a result, it is our responsibility to take our speech and debate skills into the real world, most clearly manifested through advocacy.

GIVEN EVERYTHING YOU'VE ACCOMPLISHED, HOW DO YOU MEASURE SUCCESS?

Fairly measuring my own success is still something I struggle with. However, I think it's really important to hold yourself to the same standard as you do for others, and be willing to celebrate yourself. With that being said, I see my success reflected in my team. I have been coaching debate for 2 years now, and seeing their success is a reflection of my own.

WHAT DOES SPEECH AND DEBATE MEAN TO YOU?

Coming from a family of first-generation immigrants (being one myself) and non-English speakers, activism and public advocacy wasn't an opportunity easily accessible to us. But forensics turned that on its head, providing my two younger brothers and I the rare platform to talk about issues that affected our identity. I know I'm not alone, because I've met many others in this activity who've been empowered by the self-advocacy it offers. To me, speech and debate is so much more than an academic opportunity — it's a link between my community, the issues we face, and the ability to form tenable change in other people's minds.



In short: representation. Every student deserves to feel like they belong, and that's only possible when our community is composed of people that look like us. At risk of being overly prescriptive, I think organizations like CHSSA should make a greater effort to bring in coaches of diverse backgrounds, and provide greater resources to retain them. I know how much that's meant to me personally, and I know it's the only way to meet students / their lived experiences where they're at.

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT FOR SPEECH AND DEBATE STUDENTS TO BE ADVOCATES?

Simply put, every student that competes in a round leaves having had their voice heard. Every judge that listens in on a round leaves knowing that newfound perspective. And every other person that interacts with them is exposed to that student's story. While youth voices are so often unheard and undervalued today, this 'feedback loop' of narratives allows for my generation to demand the advocacy we deserve — especially for those who might not have that channel themselves.

GIVEN EVERYTHING YOU'VE ACCOMPLISHED, HOW DO YOU MEASURE SUCCESS?

I've been beyond fortunate these past few years — having been the runner-up at our CHSSA State Championship twice, and having championed the NSDA National Tournament. But above all else, nothing has been more fulfilling than helping my school's team grow into a family. When I started four years ago, we had three active members; today, we field around twenty students to tournaments. And watching our younger students get excited about this activity vis-a-vis those accomplishments, find a place to be themselves, and grow into confident human beings — that's the true mark of success to me.

WHAT DOES SPEECH AND DEBATE MEAN TO YOU?

To me, speech and debate is where I found my voice. I became open to other opinions on worldly matters because debate required preparation for both sides of every topic. I learned that when all the cards are against you, you still have the ability to salvage your arguments and successfully persuade your audience. Debate is a process of team coordination. It's speaking for the sake of yourself and strengthening the claims of your team. Debate is not a battle of content or statistics but rather a place of advocacy.



To increase accessibility to speech and debate, we can offer gently-used formal attire to be sold at tournaments. I feel that a big part of all speech and debate events is physical presentation. Unfortunately, speech and debate attire is costly- from the clothes to tailoring to even shoes. I would not want a future in the speech and debate world where this 'professional presentation' is a hurdle for competitors who cannot afford this sort of attire. Competitors with means can donate an extra pantsuit or a pair of formal shoes that they no longer need to allow our community-regardless of economic background—to flourish.

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT FOR SPEECH AND DEBATE STUDENTS TO BE ADVOCATES?

In my opinion, advocacy outside of round is more important than any medal or trophy you win from competing in round. When you take the speaking skills that you've gained from practice and apply them in school, to yourgovernment representatives, and to those in power, the change that you want to see in the world can happen. Millions of people are envious of the confidence and knowledge that speech and debaters possess. So, you must speak up for those who cannot where it matters.

GIVEN EVERYTHING YOU'VE ACCOMPLISHED, HOW DO YOU MEASURE SUCCESS?

I measure success based on how I feel about my achievements both big and small. I set goals for myself through journaling and cross off my 'wins' or completed tasks like a to-do list. I try to be as grateful as possible by noting all the times I've tried something new. I always push myself to do better and am indifferent to failure. I reflect on the obstacles I've faced and recognize that my newfound capabilities can help me in the future. I strive to be everchanging and have succeeded in doing so.


Encourage collaboration across schools, leagues, and beyond! Provide scholarships and access to resources that are normally only available through experienced coaches. Make it easy to split judging shifts for students whose parents and siblings aren't able to sacrifice an entire day to judge. Encourage authenticity and passion in speeches rather than the development of a formula to win. Consider keeping some invitationals online! The cost of travel and housing, finding chaperones willing to travel, and the time and energy needed to apply for grants can all be very discouraging to students. Now there are also obviously problems with equity in online tournaments as fancy tech equipment, a quiet space, and stable internet connection can all impact a performance. I know first hand how it feels to have my computer crash in the middle of my performance at OPP finals at the state championship. Bigger teams that have support from your schools, consider opening your doors to smaller teams in your area that might benefit from having a building to perform in for said tournaments.

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT FOR SPEECH AND DEBATE STUDENTS TO BE ADVOCATES?

It is important for speech and debate students to be advocates because we have been given the power and platform to do so. Every student has the ability to write a speech and tell a story important to them. Starting small, we can change and open minds to new perspectives.

GIVEN EVERYTHING YOU'VE ACCOMPLISHED, HOW DO YOU MEASURE SUCCESS?

For me, success is measured in people that I've helped and reached. Being told I've inspired someone to write a speech, motivated people to try new events, inspired a change in thinking, moved someone to tears, or helped someone feel seen/represented is when I feel most proud.




CHSSA Student of the Year Nominee:

WHAT DOES SPEECH AND DEBATE MEAN TO YOU?

Speech and debate has been an invaluable part of my life for the past 6 years. . I've met some of my best friends through this activity who continue to challenge and inspire me to be better. It's my creative outlet and I revel in the process from finding a script all the way to performing it. Although I'm entering my last year, my memories of advancing at Nationals for the first time and meeting my private coach in person will remain with me, as will my affinity for pink blazers and pearls at 6 am on Saturdays.



In order to keep speech and debate accessible to all students regardless of background, I think that all tournaments should maintain an online division. During COVID, I was able to attend, from my own home, tournaments that typically would've been hosted around the country and thus, inaccessible to me. For so many students across the country, including myself, traveling to lots of different tournaments each semester is not possible and tough choices need to be made.

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT FOR SPEECH AND DEBATE STUDENTS TO BE ADVOCATES?

Because this activity gives us a voice, it is imperative that we use it. As young people, we rarely get the chance to speak uninterrupted to a captive audience about what matters to us. Speech and debate gives us this platform and it is crucial that we take this opportunity to offer our unique view of the world and challenge the audience to rethink their own views through this new lens.

GIVEN EVERYTHING YOU'VE ACCOMPLISHED, HOW DO YOU MEASURE SUCCESS?

A successful tournament is partly the result of feeling good about my performances, being in control of my own emotions, and having fun performing my pieces. Recently, though, I've realized I equate success with connection. If just one person comes up to me after a round or a day of competing and tells me that what I had to say mattered to them, that's when I feel truly successful. As a Jewish student performing a piece about anti-semitism this year, it has been incredibly meaningful when peers tell me that they felt seen by what I had to say. It is at that moment, bonding over the vital importance of words, that I feel uniquely successful.

It was her success there that ultimately earned her the honor of being inducted into the CHSSA Hall of Fame.

Each year since Lynette's passing the California High School Speech Association has adopted the spirit of learning, caring, and kindness that Lynette embodied in giving out the Impromptu Speaking: Most Inspirational Speaker Award. This award is chosen by the student competitors in Lynette's favorite event, Impromptu to be given to a student that the other competitors in the final round best used their words to inspire their peers.


